Pulmonology is also called Chest Medicine and Respiratory Medicine. A pulmonologist is a physician who specialises in diagnosing and treating patients with illnesses that affect the lungs, breathing and sleep.

WHAT WE TREAT

Pulmonologists are specially trained in diseases and conditions of the Chest, Particularly Bronchial Asthma, COPD, Pleural Effusion, Interstitial Lung Disease, Tuberculosis, Pneumonia, Obstructive Sleep Apnea (OSA) and other complicated Chest Infections like COVID (Corona Virus) And Swine Flu (H1N1) Pneumonia. Pulmonology often involves managing patients who need life support and mechanical ventilation.

WHO NEEDS A PULMONOLOGIST CONSULTATION?

- Treatment of lung cancer
- Difficult to treat asthma, COPD and bronchiectasis
- Treatment of drug-resistant TB (MDR and XDR TB)
- Management of mediastinal mass/lymph nodes - EBUS (Endo Bronchial Ultrasound)
- Management of respiratory failure / ARDS (BiPAP and Ventilatory Management)
- Management of complicated pneumonia (including COVID-19 and H1N1 - Swine flu pneumonia)
- Diagnosis (sleep study polysomnography) and treatment of sleep apnea (CPAP and BiPAP)
- Pulmonary vascular disease like the management of pulmonary hypertension and thrombolysis (pulmonary embolism)
- Pulmonary rehabilitation for patients with chronic respiratory diseases or

patients who need home oxygen therapy

- Management of interstitial lung diseases including full PFT (Spirometry, total lung capacity, diffusion capacity, six-minute walk test)
- Patients who have persistent cough, difficulty in breathing, hemoptysis (blood on cough/ sputum), chest pain, excessive snoring during the night and sleepiness during the day
- Management of tubercular and parapneumonic effusion/empyema (diagnostic and therapeutic pleural aspiration, intercostal drainage tube insertion, pigtail insertion, medical thoracoscopy)
- Diagnosis and treatment of pulmonary opacity/lesion by bronchoscopic interventions like fibreoptic bronchoscopy and related procedures (broncho-alveolar lavage, endobronchial biopsy, tran bronchial needle aspiration, tran bronchial biopsy, control of hemoptysis, brushing, foreign ody/mucus plug removal, etc)

1. Why did you choose to become a doctor as your career path?

I like to read medical journals and research articles to stay current with the latest advancements in vascular medicine and healthcare in general. I attend many CMEs and conferences on vascular updates to keep myself updated with the latest ongoing research and advancement in vascular medicine.

4. What is the best medical success story of your career so far?

A 50-year-old, who had diabetes for over



two decades was battling with acute leg

pain. He was taking it in his stride but his

left leg was turning an alarming shade of purple and his pain had become unbearable. His family rushed him to Aadicura, and the diagnosis was clear - it was gangrene, a potentially lifethreatening condition that often necessitates limb amputation. We recognized the urgency of the situation and, instead of resorting to immediate amputation, we performed a complex vascular reconstruction to restore blood flow to the affected leg. Over the course of several surgeries, we meticulously cleared the blocked arteries and repaired the damaged blood vessels. His leg slowly regained its natural colour, and the excruciating pain began to subside. His recovery was nothing short of a miracle. Months later, he stood on both his legs. This extraordinary success story not only saved the patient's limbs but also his quality of life.

5. If you were to describe yourself in three words, what would they be and why?

Skilled, compassionate and detailoriented.

6. Being a doctor can be very stressful.

How do you practice a healthy balance between work and your personal life?

I like to keep a specific work schedule and try to stick to it as closely as possible. I also do regular exercise, meditation, practice my hobbies and spend time with loved ones. SPYGLASS CHOLANGIOSCOPY
IN UNRESECTABLE
CHOLANGIOCARCINOMA

Recently at Aadicura Institute of Gastroenterology and Hepatobiliary Sciences (AIGHS), a wing of Aadicura Hospital, our doctors treated an unusual and interesting case of SpyGlass Cholangioscopy with Spybite and Bilateral Metallic Stenting in Unresectable Cholangiocarcinoma.

The patient - a 62-year-old male - was presented with obstructive jaundice with fever in a known case of Diabetes Mellitus (DM) and cirrhosis of the liver. Upon evaluation by the experts, an MRCP test was conducted. The results were suggestive of cholangiocarcinoma Type 3B. Type 3B means that the cancer has spread to organs or tissues near the liver, such as the duodenum, colon, stomach, common bile duct, abdominal wall, diaphragm, or the part of the vena cava behind the liver, or the cancer has spread

to nearby lymph node.

Subsequently, an endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography (ERCP) which is an endoscopic procedure used to identify the presence of

stones, tumors, or narrowing in the biliary and pancreatic ducts was performed on the patient. And brush cytology method was used for a broad sampling of the mucosal surface. The results of which turned out negative.

Following this, our team of expert doctors conducted a Spyglass cholangioscopy (a procedure for direct examination of the bile ducts using a small caliber scope) with Spybite which revealed adenocarcinoma cancers on Rapid On-Site Evaluation (ROSE).

cholangiocarcinoma, the best option was to conduct bilateral simultaneous metallic stenting for palliation after considering the Oncosurgeon's opinion. Unresectable cholangiocarcinoma means that the cancer cannot be completely removed with surgery. The least we could do was to ease the severity of pain or disease without removing the cause.

The patient is doing well and the plan is palliative chemotherapy once bilirubin (a yellowish pigment that is made during the breakdown of red blood cells) decreases.
